



Scrap Buy Back Program

Overview

Our commitment to providing you with quality products with consistent performance continues past the end of the product's useful life. FC Mill Liners, Inc. will purchase worn liners and other approved metal parts to help you manage the disposal of materials that are no longer of use to your operation.

How Can You Benefit?

- Recycle materials that are at the end of their useful life
- Reduce the time and effort you spend disposing of worn materials
- Recover the residual value of worn components
- Offset the costs of new mill liners and accessories

How Does the Scrap Buy Back Program Work?

- Contact your Account Manager to request a quote for your worn liners and other accepted scrap.
 - Quotes are based on the price per short ton (2,000 lbs.) for different alloy types.
 - The quote price is inclusive of pick up, scrap preparation and freight charges.
 - A list of accepted and excluded items follows this section.
- Once the guote is approved, we will coordinate pick up and transportation.
 - Net scrap weight is established at pick up.
 - Final weight and alloy types are confirmed on receipt at our production facility.
- You can then choose how you want to receive or apply your payment:
 - Check
 - ACH transfer
 - Wire transfer
 - Account credit

Accepted Items

- SAG mill liners
- Ball mill liners
- Chute and bin liners
- Alloy steel concaves
- Drill bits
- Angle iron <6 ft. in length
- Bolts
- Pump cases, impellers, suction side liners, and other metal pump components

Excluded Items

- Grinding balls
- Manganese steel, such as is used in some primary gyratory and secondary crushers
- Crusher mantles and manganese concaves
- Thin section steel, such as sheet steel or plate steel
- Aluminum based scrap
- Bronze bushings
- Brass scrap
- Copper scrap
- Scrap containing sulfur residuals
- Any other scrap that is not iron or steel based

Additional Considerations

- For faster service, please group items of the same alloy type together in your scrap yard. For example, separate SAG mill liners, ball mill liners and pump parts into different piles.
- If you don't know the alloy type of an item, please refer to your Account Manager for assistance. We may be able to help you determine it.
